Parent Right-To-Know Letter

Title I - 2018-2019 School Year

Dear Parent/Guardian

In accordance with ESEA Section 1111(h)(6) Parents Right-To-Know, Country Club Hills School District 160 (CCH160) is notifying every parent of a student in a Title I school that you have the right, and may request information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher. This information regarding the professional qualifications of your child's classroom teacher including, at minimum, the following:

- 1. Whether the teacher has met State qualificators and licensing criteria for the grade levels and subject areas in which the teacher provides instruction.
- 2. Whether the teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status though which State qualification of licensing criteria have been waived.
- 3. The baccalaureate degree major of the teacher and any other graduate certification or degree held by the teacher, and the field of discipline of the certification or degree.
- 4. Whether the child is provided services by a paraprofessional and if so; their qualifications.

If at any time your child has been taught for four or more consecutive weeks by a teacher not highly qualified; the school will notify you.
