Health Requirements for Registration

In order to complete the registration process the following must be provided to the school office prior to the first day of school attendance.

According to Board of Education policy, compliance with these health requirements documented on the correct forms and signed by a medical professional are required to enroll a student in the district. Students will not be eligible to attend school until the information has been approved by the school nurse. It is recommended school physicals and immunizations be completed and returned to the school no later than August 1, 2016.

Certificate of Child Health Examination/Physical

If your child is entering school for the first time, kindergarten, and sixth grade:

Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination Form for the 2016-2017 school year completed and signed by a physician.

Required Immunizations

Early childhood and Pre-K: HIB and Pneumococcal, Hepatitis B series

Kindergarten students will require several new immunizations*

Sixth through Eighth grade: Tdap, completion of Hepatitis B series

Sixth and Seventh grade: Meningococcal

Kindergarten through Eighth grade: 2 doses of varicella

**Consult your health care provider for additional specific immunization requirements or contact the school nurse.*

Dental Examination

All students entering kindergarten, second, and sixth grade must have a dental examination for the 2016-2017 school year.

Eye Examination

Kindergarten students must have a new eye examination by a licensed optometrist before October 15, 2016.
